Know where the stopcock or water valve is located. if it can be accessed easily and how to use it.

**MOST IMPORTANTLY** if a brass

stopcock or brass valve is fitted. check it has not been affected by limescale and seized up. If it has, or for better, instant protection, ask a plumber to install a Surestop water control valve. It's guick and simple to fit, as well as easier to use.

Many boilers have a condensate pipe which can freeze and stop them from working. If this occurs, check the error code and look it up in the manual or on-line. It may tell you how to fix it without calling a tradesperson.
